### OCTOBER - MONTH OF THE HOLY ROSARY

The Holy Father has decided to invite all the faithful, of all the world, to pray the Holy Rosary every day, during the entire Marian month of October, and thus to join in communion and in penitence, as the people of God, in asking the Holy Mother of God and Saint Michael Archangel to protect the Church.

We would encourage as many people as possible to gather and pray the Rosary in the church before the 10am Mass daily, in St. Michael's, and at the Grotto on the Courtown Road at 7.30pm every Thursday. Please organise some friends, neighbours or family to gather and pray the Rosary during October.

### REFLECTION - OUR DAILY GOSPEL

I'll ask you a question, but I don't want you to answer: How many of you read a passage of the Gospel every day? How many of you, perhaps, rush to finish work so you don't miss a TV programme? To have a Gospel in your hands, to have the Gospel on your bedside table, to have the Gospel in your pocket, to open it and read the Word of Jesus: this is how the kingdom of God comes. Contact with the Word of God draws us near to the kingdom of God. Consider this: a small Gospel always to hand, ready to open when the opportunity arises, ready to read what Jesus says. We can make it easier to give space to God and his Word by having a small book of the Gospels or Bible handy and reading it often. When we are eating our breakfast, waiting for someone, or have a couple of minutes to spare, we can read our pocket Bible before we turn to an electronic device or the TV.
